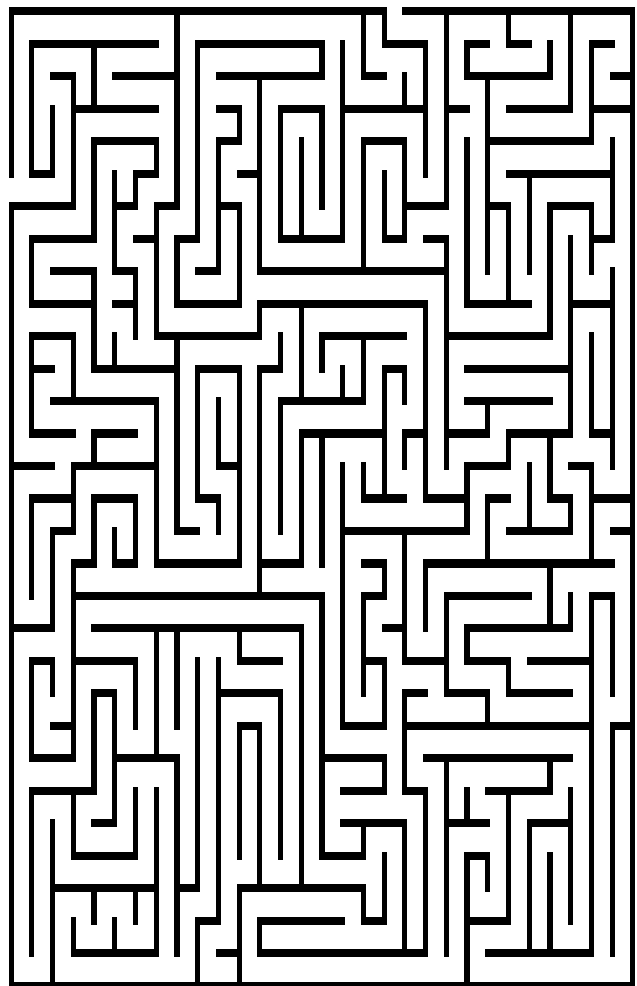
In 1789 President George Washington announced the First ever National Thanksgiving Holiday.
